

OUR HISTORY

The dawn of 2020 was indeed full of uncertainty and unchartered territory as the world faced a global pandemic and our founder, Apostle Tommy E. Quick endured the greatest trial of his life. This time of physical and social isolation was not absent of God's voice as He spoke clearly to Apostle Quick regarding the need to restore families. On God's direction, the mission and movement of Christian Families Against Destructive Decisions (CFADD), was birthed in Spartanburg, South Carolina.

The first planning sessions took place in April and the team worked urgently to complete the organizing, branding and other administrative details needed to officially establish the organization as a non-profit 501(c)(3) in September 2020. CFADD's website and social media presence grew rapidly upon it's launch, capturing over 1,000 dedicated followers within a month. A kickoff rally was held in October 2020 in partnership with the Beacon Drive-In and attendees encouraged the vision by traveling from across the Carolinas and Virginia.

In August 2021, CFADD endeavored to host its first and now signature annual event, a National Family Conference; it was themed The Case for CFADD. It was an overwhelming success and year after year, in-person and virtual workshops have premiered the most renowned experts in their professions expounding on various topics that address our family and the Godly solutions we must take. Keynote speakers have included our very own founder, Apostle Quick, the late Dean Nelson, Lt. Governor Mark Robinson, Bishop Patrick Wooden Sr and the legendary Dr. Bob Woodson.

Each year CFADD continues to build upon the mission that God has given.

In 2021, CFADD began developing mission driven programming, which has expanded each year. With a solid governance structure, the CFADD board and steering committee are aligned on strategic goals and actions which include:

- 1) training program content development and awareness/availability
- 2) family policy advocacy
- 3) organization sustainability

With these in view, the team has worked hard in achievement of a Platinum Transparency rating for Candid/Charity One audits.

Locally, CFADD stays connected to its flagship community through various outreach initiatives annually. To name a few, Spring Fling, Spartanburg Christmas Parade, community cookouts, prayer walks, Christmas Give-a-way, Father's Day Brunch, CFADDforKids and other grassroots efforts as the need arises.

CFADD's programs, which are offered to support its mission expand each year to meet the growing demand. In 2022, CFADD's Moms on a Mission (MOMs) recognized it's first CFADD Mother of the Year. MOMs have continued to gain momentum and now prints a newsletter, giving much-needed support to all moms. Likewise, Dads at Duty (DADs), staple Father's Day event continues to attract 100s of men each year, reconnecting and recovering relationships that were severed.

The CFADD College Chapter that started on the University of South Carolina Upstate Campus has impacted over 200 students to embrace the divine order of family.

The CFADD chapter and affiliate network continues to grow and the diverse partnerships, is exampled by the expansive relationship CFADD has developed with Southern Wesleyan University.

Embarking to influence the next generation of ministry leaders, SWU, is investing in CFADD participating churches who have college bound students through tailored scholarship opportunities.

On the hills of the 2023 National Family Conference, CFADD began its first largescale fundraising campaign with a donor matching dollar for dollar up to \$100,000! It was a huge feat for a non-profit, run primarily by volunteers, but in under 90 days, it was done. This was just the catapult the organization needed. In late November, the CFADD Family University launched with its highly anticipated Family Champion course. In early 2024, CFADD Universe, a private and safe social media community, was launched. This would soon house similar platforms for targeted groups. Now there's Connected for teens and young adults, Just Parents and the Black Man Resurgence communities where likeminded believers can gain information, share stories, be encouraged and be protected from secular social media influences. God was at work, stirring the heart of our founder to penetrate the local community. In the spring of 2024, God's vision was made plain as CFADD made plans to open its first Family Training Center and its National Headquarters. Following a great witnessing effort at Spartanburg's Spring Fling, CFADD welcomed over 550 guests to its grand opening event in May 2024. CFADD gaveaway a car, 75 bicycles to adults and children, as well as over \$1000 in gift cards, food, and gifts. Previews of training center offerings and tours were giving. It was a phenomenal day!

In May, we celebrated Wombman Month, for all those born with a womb, signifying the special value placed on women by God. The Mother of the Year was renamed the Ruby Award.

Over 20 mothers were beautifully recognized, but one exemplary mother was chosen as the Ruby. Mother Estelle Quick, mother of our founder, was the 2023 Ruby. This was followed by 'Man-Up' month for men in June when we hosted our annual Father's Day Brunch to the theme Family: The Superbowl of Life.

We were joined by over 200 guests, former NFL football player Jack Brewer, former boxer Duke Tanner and our founder, Apostle Quick who led a legendary panel.

CFADD's advocacy work continued this past year, as our founder and several other members spoke out at the South Carolina State Board of Education meeting, influencing legislation that will give teachers less latitude on books that are presented without parental consent in the classroom and in the school library. CFADD's founder has been invited, attended and presented at several conferences nationwide including Douglas Leadership Institute, Road to the Majority, Student's for Life in Columbia to name a few. In recent months his attention has turned locally to the community of Spartanburg and gathering more local focus on the Family Training Center, writing a book and his new podcast for men.

The vision is still burning strong! We are grateful for how the Lord is guiding our leader and providing every resource. By His grace we will continue to influence the building and sustaining of strong families and strong generational heritages through a biblical worldview and God first lifestyle.

Apostle Tommy E. Quick is the Senior Pastor and Founder of The Spartanburg Christian Discipleship Center, now The Promised Land Church of God in Christ, where he has served for over 31 years. His ministry spans 48 years, and he has successfully pioneered three churches in North and South Carolina and built three edifices for the glory of God. He is a multi-gifted Apostle, Pastor, Teacher, Preacher and Prophet whose ministry is accompanied by miracles, signs, and wonders.

He presently serves as the Chief of Staff, the Superintendent of the SC District, and Chairman of Ordination Committee in the NC3rd Ecclesiastical Jurisdiction COGIC with Bishop Patrick L. Wooden Sr. Apostle Quick can be seen every Sunday morning on The Promised Place Broadcast – the most watched Christian Broadcast in Upstate, SC. He has been married to Valerie for 39 years; they have 5 children, 12 grandchildren and 4 great grands.

His heart for family has been displayed since he arrived in Spartanburg in 1992. Through his leadership he established the Adult Child Enrichment Program enabling parents and children with literacy issues to be tutored. In 1993, he led the establishment of Positive Direction for Youth to provide positive alternatives for youth. In 1995, he expanded the ministry to bus youth from all over the county to feed and provide biblical instruction.

From 2004–2012, he headed a 21st Century After School Program to help 100 students each year and their parents, from Woodland Heights Elementary School by providing snacks, homework help, tutoring, character building, social enrichment, and parental support.

In 2008, to increase home ownership and provide a safe environment for families and their children he successfully undertook the development of Trinity Gates subdivision, a 47-home neighborhood adjoining the Promised Land Church. That same year, he founded Black Boys of Distinction, (now TEAM: Tomorrow's Exemplary & Anointed Men) a unique mentoring program for at-risk boys.

In 2013, he was awarded the Human Rights Award by the Church Women United, Inc. from the United Nations Office.

As of August 1, 2015, he leads Legacy Christian School, where his love for children and vision for excellence can be seen every day. His goal is for Legacy Christian School to be the premiere Christian Preschool and Elementary School in the Upstate.

Apostle Quick has suffered persecution and prosecution for his unwavering faith, uncompromising stance on the Biblical Worldview, and service to mankind. In 2020 he received the vision for Christian Families Against Destructive Decisions (CFADD.org) a Non-Profit 501C3 organization with 11 chapters in 5 states. CFADD's mission is to influence the building and sustaining of strong families and strong generational heritages by promoting a Biblical worldview and God-first lifestyle.

Apostle Quick's motto, "I found my life in the church and now the church has become my life," drives his endeavor to put God First in all areas of his life.







It's Time to Talk about Protecting Children

Burlington, NC

Based on focus groups and surveys conducted in 6 battleground states among moderate Americans:

- ✓ By a two-to-one margin, battleground voters agree that discussions of sexuality and gender identity are best left to parents.




