CELEBRATING FIVE YEARS OF HISTORY

2020

During the COVID-19 pandemic, Apostle Tommy E. Quick received divine direction to restore families, birthing the vision for CFADD.

CFADD officially became a 501(c)(3) nonprofit in September 2020.

CFADD held its first Public Rally in October 2020, drawing supporters from across multiple states.

2021

CFADD hosted its **First National Family Conference** in August, themed **The Case for CFADD**, launching its
signature annual event.

CFADD received a **Gold Transparency Rating** from
Candid/Charity One for its
governance and accountability.

Prominent speakers such as
Dr. Robert Woodson headlined
the conference.

Strategic programs were developed to support the mission: content training, policy advocacy, and sustainability.

Community outreach efforts flourished locally through events like Spring Fling, Christmas Giveaways, and prayer walks.

2022

CFADD established its first College Chapter at USC Upstate, impacting over 200 students. The 199 Men Father's Day event continued growing, reconnecting fathers with families.

CFADD's Moms on a Mission (MOMs) awarded its first **CFADD Mother of the Year** and launched a regular newsletter. Local and national program growth continued with expanded reach and targeted initiatives.

2023

CFADD launched its first large-scale fundraising campaign, raising \$100,000 in under 90 days.

CFADD launched the Marriage Boot Camp to promote biblical marriage through counseling, support, and no-cost weddings for participating couples. CFADD expanded advocacy, influencing education policy at the South Carolina State Board of Education.

The **CFADD Universe** private social media community was created for safe, faith-based engagement.

The **CFADD Family University** debuted in November, launching with the cornerstone Family Champion course.

2024

CFADD opened its first Family
Training Center and National
Headquarters in May.

CFADD received a **Platinum Transparency Rating** from Candid/Charity One for its
governance and accountability.

CFADD partnered with Southern
Wesleyan University to offer a 50%
tuition scholarship for students from
CFADD church affiliates.

The grand opening event welcomed 550+ guests with giveaways and tours.

CFADD celebrated **Wo(mb)man Month** in May and **Man-Up Month**in June with impactful events.

Advocacy work continued, and Apostle Quick increased his presence at national conferences.

2025

CFADD kicked off the **Family Revival Tour**, traveling across several states
addressing many families and leaders.

CFADD expanded its reach with the launch of its streaming app, **CFADD TV** on four major platforms.

Apostle Tommy E. Quick released his book,
"The Untapped Power of the Family",
equipping families with tools to build strong,
generational family capital.

CFADD commemorated **five years of impact** during the 2025 Family Conference.
